
PetroVietnam Ca Mau Fertilizer Joint Stock Company (DCM) hereby notifies shareholders and investors of the performance results in August 2023 and outlines the production and business plan for September 2023, details are as follows:

1. PRODUCTION AND BUSINESS RESULTS IN AUGUST 2023

- Urea production output in August 2023 has reached **50,16 thousand tons**. Production output in August is lower than the previous month, attributed to periodic scheduled downtime. The maintenance commenced on August 17th, 2023, and concluded on August 25th, 2023, one day ahead of schedule.
- Urea consumption in August 2023 has reached 131,95 thousand tons, with domestic consumption at 57,91 thousand tons, exports at 74,04 thousand tons.
- NPK production output in August 2023 has reached 9,25 thousand tons.

Production and business results of PVCFC nitrogen fertilizers




2. PRODUCTION AND BUSINESS PLAN FOR SEPTEMBER 2023

- Planned urea production output for September 2023 is projected at **78,58 thousand** tons. Planned urea consumption for September 2023 is projected at **60,00 thousand** tons.
- Planned NPK production output for September 2023 is projected at 11,00 thousand tons. Planned NPK consumption for September 2023 is projected at 15,00 thousand tons.

3. SITUATION OF UREA FERTILIZER MARKET IN AUGUST 2023

- Since the beginning of August, urea fertilizer prices have reached a record high in the last 3 months in major markets, including China and the Middle East, following a consistent rise in global urea prices for 5 consecutive weeks.
- Throughout August 2023, the tightening of supply has driven fertilizer prices upward. In a notable move, China has called on several fertilizer producers to halt urea exports temporarily, in response to escalating domestic demand and soaring market prices.
